#### **BAVARIAN ROYAL CASTLES:**

8:00AM: Meet the guide and drive from your hotel in Sölden via Imst over the Fernpass to Ehrwald and Reutte to Bavaria. You will visit the fairytale-like Neuschwanstein castle in Bavaria, with 1.4 million visitors per year, one of the three most visited tourist attractions in Germany. The Disney castle is located in the village of Hohenschwangau in the hills of the green region Allgäu in Bavaria. ### FULL DAY TOUR TO INNSBRUCK AND SWAROVSKI

8:00AM: Drive from your Hotel in Sölden to Swarovski Crystal World in Wattens. The Swarovski Crystal Worlds was opened in 1995 to mark the centennial anniversary of the company's founding. Multimedia artist André Heller designed a unique and magical place. This beloved attraction has brought moments of wonder to over sixteen million visitors from all around the world. Visitors are surprised, touched, and perhaps even transformed by crystal in all its facets. Afterwards continue to Innsbruck where your city guide will show you the most important monuments of the Alpine Town of Innsbruck's city centre. The imperial palace "Hofburg", the imperial chapel "Hofkirche", the cathedral of Innsbruck, the Golden Roof, the city tower and many other places of interest in the narrow streets of the old town. (entrances excluded) After all these impressions you have some time on your own for shopping or have an "Apple Strudel" before you return to your Hotel in Sölden by 6:00PM. ## Wednesday, March 13th: **GORGE:**



#### FULL DAY TOUR TO GARMISCH, GERMANY & PARTNACH

8:00AM: Drive from your Hotel in Sölden via Zirl, Seefeld to Garmisch-Partenkirchen. Your first stop will be the magic Partnach Gorge in a unique natural setting. Several million years ago, meltwater and debris hollowed out the rock leaving this narrow gorge. The moment when you enter the Partnach Gorge you find yourself surrounded by massive rock faces. While strolling past the impressive rock faces, you'll be amazed at all the new and breath-taking perspectives that await you along the trail. Afterwards visit Garmisch city centre and stroll through the historic Frühlingstrasse. You see colorful Lüftlmalerei mural paintings on the facades. These artistic creations frame the historic district of Garmisch like the open pages of a picture book. Their stories tell of piety, names and professions, hopes and fears of the people. Originally, the street was a rural alpine settlement. Today, it attracts visitors from all over the world. Return via Ehrwald and Imst to your Hotel in Sölden by 5PM. #### FULL DAY TOUR TO ST. ANTON FOR SKIERS (and non-skiers): Friday, March 15<sup>th</sup>:



8:00AM: Depart your hotel in Sölden via Landeck to St. Anton am Arlberg. The charming ski resort is considered to be the epicenter of winter sports by many. Excellent snow conditions and state-of-the-art cable cars and lifts have passionate skiers from around the globe visit the Arlberg every winter. They all enjoy the comfort of taking the Galzigbahn cable car directly from the village up into the heart of the ski resort – and then the Vallugabahn cable car to the peak of the same name at 2,811 meters. After all, you can take the longest slope in the ski resort - nine kilometers and 1,350 meters of elevation loss - right from the Valluga ridge down to St. Anton (via Ulmerhütte). Enjoy your day Skiing or just visit the viewing platform Top of Valluga on 2810m. After a whole day at the famous resort, you will depart at 4:30PM, arriving in Sölden by 5:30PM. (Travel time 1 Hour each direction)
